DID YOU KNEAUX??

Louisiana's Ragin' Cajuns have had tremendous success on the offensive side of the ball. The Cajuns have had a number of players among the best in the NCAA.

On April 15, 1995, Tiffany Whittall set the NCAA record with 11 RBI against Samford. Whittall belted a pair of grand slams in the contest.

Tiffany Whittall and Danyele Gomez are tied for third in NCAA history with 13 total bases in a game. Whittall accomplished the feat against Samford on April 15, 1995. Gomez matched the effort on March 14, 2006 against Mississippi Valley State.

Danyele Gomez had an amazing senior season. In 2006, Gomez led the nation in runs scored (77), home runs (30) and slugging percentage (.957). Her 77 runs scored and .957 slugging percentage is good enough for 17th in NCAA history, while her 30 homers is tied for third best.

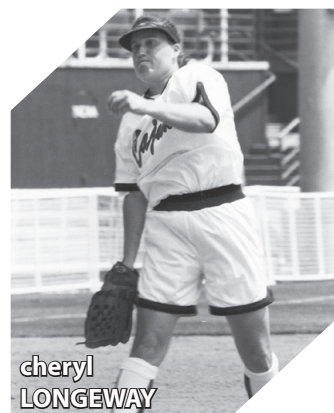
Lacey Bertucci led the nation with 61 walks in 2007, while in 2001, Alana Addison led the nation with 79 runs batted in, tying her for 15th in NCAA history.

Jerie Alexander, Brittany Bryant, Danyele Gomez, Jana Mower, Jill Robertson and Dorsey Steamer all finished their UL career with NCAA career marks. Alexander ranks 11th in NCAA history with 230 runs scored, while Bryant is 29th with 127 career walks. Gomez holds two career marks. She ranks fourth in the NCAA with 83 home runs and fifth with 246 RBI. Mower is tied for 10th with 65 career doubles, while Robertson ranks ninth with 34 times being hit by a pitch. Steamer ranks 12 in NCAA history with 149 stolen bases in her career.

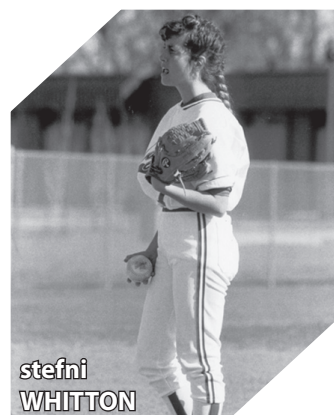
Louisiana's Ragin' Cajuns have been among the best in the NCAA on defense. A number of Cajuns have been among the top of the NCAA both on the field and in the circle.

In the circle, Brooke Mitchell and Kyla Hall set a pair of NCAA top marks for a single season. Mitchell finished the 2004 season with 45 victories, which is tied for fifth best in NCAA history. She ranks eighth in the NCAA for strikeouts. Mitchell posted a Ragin' Cajuns record 524 K's in 2004. Hall completed the 1994 season with a .912 win-loss percentage which is good enough for 20th in NCAA history. Her 31-3 overall record is remains atop the single-season record book. Hall compiled a miniscule 0.23 earned run average in 1992. Her ERA still ranks 18th in NCAA history.

The pair of Kyla Hall and Brooke Mitchell combined for four NCAA career marks. Hall's 104-20 (.839) career record is 14th best in NCAA career history. Mitchell has three school records that rank in the NCAA top-25. Her 119 career victories places her in a tie for 11th in career wins. Mitchell's 146 career starts ranks 16th in NCAA history, while her 1,309 strikeouts ranks 12th.

Defensively, Joy Webre ranks fifth in NCAA history with 629 putouts in a season. Her 1,818 career putouts is good enough for fourth in the NCAA record books.

Alana Addison had 538 assists in her career, which ranks 16th in NCAA history.
