2010 YEAR IN REVIEW



In 2010, Louisiana secured its first winning season and a berth in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament for the first time since 2002. UL held a remarkable 10-2 record at home, notching the most match victories at home since 1988.

■ Bucking the Trend

Louisiana captured its first winning season since 2002 after securing a 17-16 overall record. UL captured the most victories in the rally era and earned a tournament berth for the first time since 2002.

■ Home Sweet Home

The Ragin' Cajuns won 83 percent of their home matches during the 2010 campaign, capping off a 10-2 record at the friendly confines of Earl K. Long Gym. The 10 home victories were the most for the Cajuns since notching 12 wins in 1988.

■ A Ragin' Beginning

UL opened the season with a 7-1 mark, capturing the best start since 1990. Louisiana snagged its first in-season tournament title since 2002 with a sweep of the Ragin' Cajuns Invitational. Louisiana defeated Houston Baptist (3-2), Jackson State (3-0) and Nicholls State (3-1) to secure the tournament crown.

■ The Streaking Cajuns

Louisiana put together a stretch of six consecutive wins dating from Aug. 28 to Sept. 7. The streak was the longest since UL claimed six straight from Oct. 27 to Nov. 25, 2002.

■ A Team of Aces

The Ragin' Cajuns led the Sun Belt with 202 service aces, averaging 1.69 aces per game. The mark ranked 17th in the NCAA.

■ Reaching New Heights

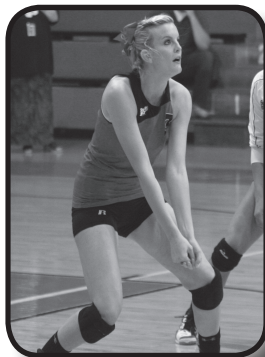
Seven conference victories in the Sun Belt was the highest mark for the Cajuns since Becky Madden's squad earned nine wins in 2002. It was also a historic season as Louisiana knocked off UALR for only the third time in program history and also picked up conference victories over Arkansas State and Florida Atlantic.

■ Making the Climb

Under the direction of head coach Heather Mazeitis, the Ragin' Cajuns have gradually improved every season. Mazeitis has taken the Cajuns to their first double-digit win total in eight years, while improving the 2010 win total by eight from the previous season. Mazeitis has accumulated the most wins of any coach in her first three seasons since Chris Campbell posted 46 victories from 1999-2001.

■ Non-Conference Success

For the second consecutive season, the Cajuns' improved their non-conference win total under head coach Heather Mazeitis. UL notched 10 non-conference wins, the most since the 1997 campaign.



Lindsay Brown finished her career with 1,863 digs, the most for any Cajuns player during the rally era.

■ Garnering Accolades

Junior **Lesley Mirarchi** became the first University of Louisiana volleyball player to earn All-Sun Belt honors since 2002 when she was named second team All-Sun Belt Conference last season. UL had three athletes earn All-Louisiana honors in 2010. **Lindsay Brown** and Mirarchi earned second team accolades, while **Mandi Gavin** was named honorable mention.

■ Leaving a Legendary Mark

Lindsay Brown left an indelible mark on the Ragin' Cajuns volleyball program. Brown capped off her illustrious four-year career with a school single-season record 605 digs. Brown racked up 1,863 career digs, the most for any UL athlete in the rally scoring era. Brown was a two-time Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week selection in 2010. She became the first player in Cajuns history to earn a CVU.com National Player of the Week Award (Sept. 20).

■ Poised to Kill

Attacker **Lesley Mirarchi**, a second team All-Sun Belt selection, led the Cajuns with 364 kills. The junior posted 16 matches of double-digit kills, while also leading UL with a total of 106 blocks.

■ Assisting with Style

In her first year as setter, **Mandi Gavin** compiled 1,164 assists in 122 sets played for an average of 9.54 assists per game. The sophomore recorded 11 double-doubles in 2010 and was second in the Sun Belt with 44 service aces. Defensively, Gavin scooped 269 digs and tallied 86 blocks.

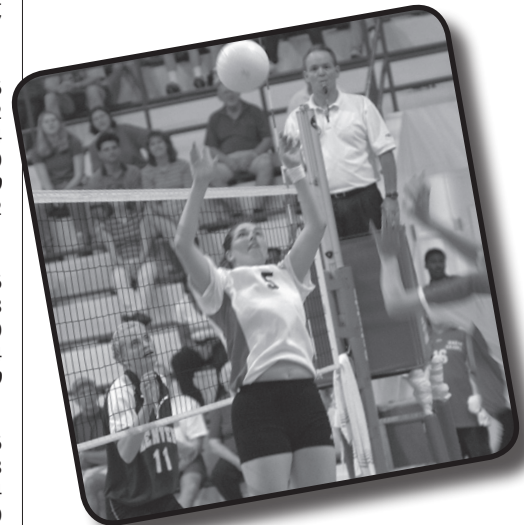

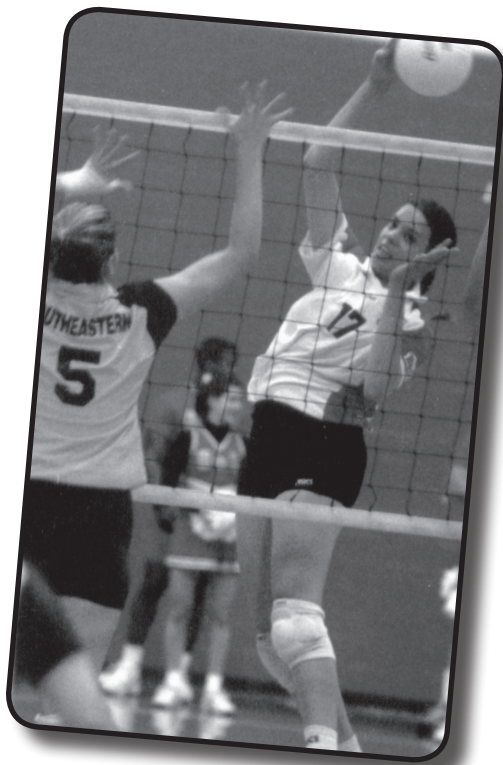
