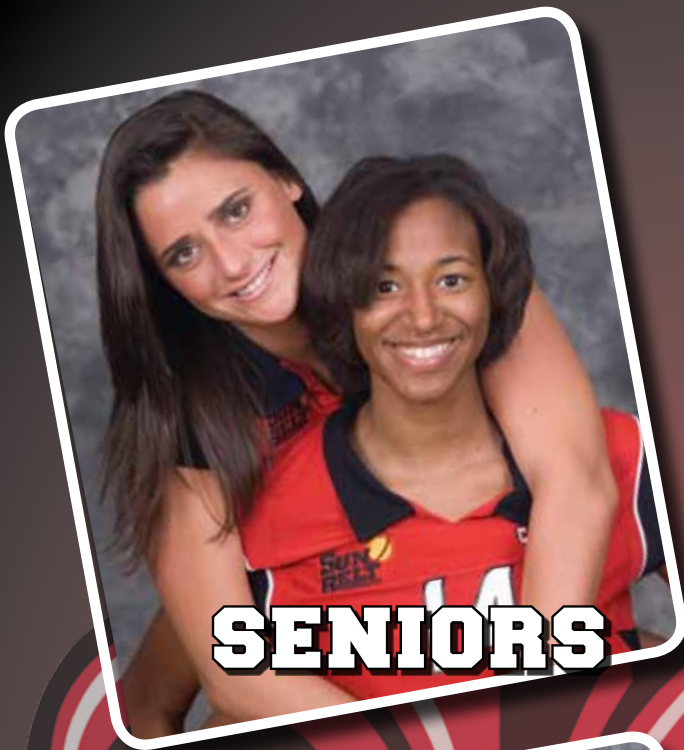

## Ragin' Cajuns Volleyball 2011 Preview

The trend upwards has been a work in progress for UL head coach **Heather Mazeitis** since arriving in 2008.

It came to fruition in 2010 when the Cajuns captured their first winning season in a decade and reached the Sun Belt Conference Tournament for the first time since 2002.

The Cajuns finished the season 17-16, notching an impressive 10-2 mark at the friendly confines of Earl K. Long Gym. The home record was the best for any Cajuns volleyball squad since 1988.

The expectation of steady improvement is the same for the 2011 Ragin' Cajuns. The loss of all-time digs leader Lindsay Brown and offensive star Caroline Dufrene will require some veterans to transition into the leadership role.

Leading that role is returning All-Sun Belt middle blocker **Lesley Mirarchi**. Last season, Mirarchi threw down 364 kills and stuffed a team-leading 106.0 blocks.

Joining Mirarchi in the leadership role is junior setter **Mandi Gavin**. Last season, Gavin ranked fourth in the Sun Belt with 9.54 assists per game becoming the first UL setter to clip the 1,000 assists plateau since 2007.

The versatility of sophomore **Taylor Meade** will help the Cajuns after she notched 259 kills and scooped 312 digs in her rookie campaign. Meade led the Sun Belt with 49 service aces.

The Cajuns will expect contributions from **Kerrilyn Lazare**, **Blair Claypoole** and **Tonice White** to help continue the offensive success from 2010. Providing the defensive depth for UL will be sophomores **Kristen Armstrong** and **Lavinia Tataran**.

Louisiana welcomes seven newcomers for 2011. **Caitlyn Auxilien** (defensive specialist) and **Andrea Hole** (setter) will provide depth for those positions. A freshmen quartet of outside hitters including **Emily Klein**, **Kaylee Nemeth**, **Kelly Weismann** and Lafayette native **Mayme Cook** will compete for a spot in the outside hitter role.

The combination of experienced veterans and skillful rookies promises to be an exciting campaign for the University of Louisiana in 2011.

## Ragin' Cajuns Volleyball BY THE NUMBERS

### 4

For the first time in four seasons the Ragin' Cajuns will have a new libero. **Lindsay Brown** finished her eligibility last season, recording a rally-era best 1,863 career digs. Potential front runners to take over the position are sophomore **Taylor Meade**, freshman **Caitlyn Auxilien** or sophomore **Kristen Armstrong**.

### 10

UL recorded 10 victories inside the friendly confines of Earl K. Long Gym in 2010. The double-digit wins at home were the most for any Ragin' Cajuns volleyball squad since snatching 12 wins in 1988.

### 17

For the first time since 2002, Louisiana eclipsed double-digit wins with 17 in the 2010 campaign. Head coach **Heather Mazeitis'** 34 wins is the most for any UL coach since Chris Campbell posted 46 from 1999 until 2001.

### 17th

Louisiana ranked first in the Sun Belt and 17th in the country last season with 206 service aces. **Taylor Meade** led the Cajuns with 49 aces, while teammate **Mandi Gavin** notched 44 aces.

### 364

**Lesley Mirarchi** inked a team-leading 364 kills (2.98 k/s) for the Cajuns in 2010. Her total was the best for any UL volleyball player since Stacey Cole threw down 424 kills in 2002.

### 461

**Mandi Gavin** is just 461 assists away from reaching UL's all-time Top 5 list for career assists. Gavin is currently fifth in the rally scoring era with 1,208 career assists.

### 2010 - Junior Season

- Sparked UL to its' first winning season since 2002 with a team-leading 364 kills (2.98 kills per set)
- Also led the Cajuns defensively with 98 block assists, and finished with 106 total blocks
- Posted 16 matches of double-digit kills
- Became the first UL athlete to earn All-Sun Belt honor since 2002
- Earned second team All-Louisiana honors alongside teammate Lindsay Brown and honorable mention honoree Mandi Gavin
- Had a career-high 25 digs with a total of 27.5 points in an epic five-set match against Houston Baptist on Sept. 3
- Was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week for Sept. 27 after recording a .365 attacking percentage in the opening conference weekend against Troy and South Alabama
- Set the rally-era record with a .750 attacking percentage at Southern, throwing down 15 kills in 20 attempts
- Stuffed a career-high eight blocks at FIU on Nov. 7

### 2009 - Sophomore Season

- Posted second consecutive season with 100-plus kills. Ended with 127 kills over 86 sets played (1.48/set)
- Had four matches with double figures in kills. Season-and career-best 16 kills came Sept. 12 vs. Prairie View A&M
- Performed well at the McNeese State Invitational as she produced 31 kills over 12 sets. Hit a season-best .471 vs. Texas-Pan American (Sept. 11), throwing down 10 kills on 17 attempts
- Beginning with the UTPA match, rolled off a string of seven consecutive matches with at least five kills - all in a one-week span

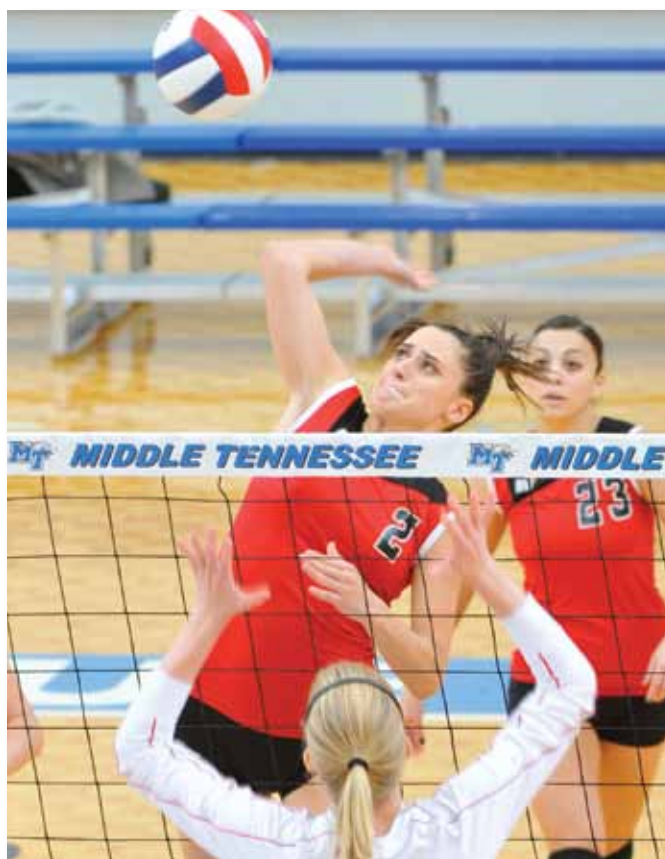
- Finished second on the team in kills with 160, at 1.68 per set, and led the squad in blocks, with 69 total

The steady rise to the top has continued every year since head coach **Heather Mazeitis** arrived at the University of Louisiana in January 2008.

Mazeitis' first campaign saw the squad double its win total from the previous season. In 2009, the Cajuns recorded their best win total since 2002.

Last season, UL notched 17 victories for the first time in a decade. In the friendly confines of Earl K. Long Gym, the Cajuns posted an impressive 10-2 record at home, marking the most home victories since 1988.

Under Mazeitis' direction Louisiana has improved its win total in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1998-2000.

The increase in winning matches plus a significant increase in attendance – which includes a higher student turnout – are two elements that have become the groundwork for the foundation of a successful program Mazeitis envisioned when she took the reigns of the program.

The 2011 season will mark the fourth for Mazeitis at UL. With the goal of having her team expect to be successful, she will look to continue the steady progress of the program.

Mazeitis has also made an impact off the court. She oversaw the recent renovation of the Cajuns' locker room and has increased the team's presence in the community by offering volleyball camps throughout the entire summer months.

Mazeitis became the 12th head volleyball coach in Ragin' Cajuns history when she assumed her current duties on January 1, 2008.

"I am truly excited over the possibilities that exist at the University of Louisiana and its volleyball program," stated Mazeitis when she was appointed head coach. "I believe

that UL volleyball can be a tremendous program in the future.

"While I admit to being proud of progress on the court – where my teams are known for technical soundness and strong will – I am most proud that I was and will always build a program within the context of an educational and ethical framework."

No stranger to Louisiana, Mazeitis spent seven seasons at the helm at Louisiana Tech from 2001-07. She coached several Techsters into the record books.

In 2005, Mazeitis was one of just 35 female coaches to be invited to attend the NCAA Women's Coaches Academy, which took place that June in Atlanta.

When Mazeitis arrived in Ruston in 2000, the program had averaged just 11 wins per season in the four previous seasons. After her first season (2001), she led Tech to back-to-back winning seasons in 2002 (19-16) and 2003 (16-15) – the first back-to-back winning season for the program since 1995-96.

She led La. Tech to a combined 53 victories in her first three seasons, an average of nearly 18 wins per season.

There were many highlights for Tech under Mazeitis, but the most impressive fact is the Lady Techsters in 2002 posted an 11-win improvement over the previous season. It tied Tech for the seventh biggest turnaround in college volleyball.

While at Louisiana Tech, Mazeitis coached five All-WAC performers and 22 Academic All-WAC honorees.

Prior to her time at Tech, Mazeitis led a successful junior college volleyball program at Kansas City (Kan.) Community College. She spent five seasons there as head coach.

The winningest coach in KCKCC history (single season and career), Mazeitis compiled a 155-110 record. Her squad was featured in the NJCAA Division I Top 20 Volleyball national rankings each of her final two seasons.

During her tenure at KCKCC, she coached 20 All-Conference athletes, nine all-region athletes and one All-American. Over 80 percent of her players earned Academic honors en-route to graduating and transferring to finish their careers at four-year programs.

In addition to coaching collegiate volleyball, Mazeitis was also involved in USA junior club volleyball in the Heart of America Region. She led her Team KC 16 & under club to the USA Volleyball junior nationals and a seventh place finish in the 2000 club season.

Mazeitis earned a degree in business administration in 1992 from Central Oklahoma where she played middle blocker.

Prior to Central Oklahoma, she had a one-year stint at Emporia State before transferring to Fort Scott Community College where Mazeitis was the only three-sport athlete in school history, playing volleyball, basketball and softball. She was later inducted into the Fort Scott Community College Hall of Fame.
