## Louisiana-Lafayette Ragin' Cajuns Head Football Coach Rickey Bustle



Louisiana-Lafayette head coach **Rickey Bustle** enters his sixth season in Cajun Country in 2007. Bustle saw his winning percentage increase each of the first five seasons since taking the job in 2002, but regressed to .500 in 2006. His 6-6 record last season was only deemed a regression because of the high standards and raised levels of expectations by the Cajuns and their fans. In fact, Bustle's 12 wins over the past two seasons are the most in a two-year period since 1994-95.

Louisiana went 3-3 at home in 2006, marking the fifth straight season – all under Bustle - that the Cajuns have been .500 or better at home. Bustle boasts a 15-12 (.556) record at Cajun Field. By comparison, the Cajuns were 6-19 (.240) at home in the five years preceding Bustle.

In addition to raised expectations, Bustle has brought professionalism and discipline to the program. Since 2002, the Cajuns 356 penalties are the fewest in the Sun Belt Conference and UL boasts the fewest penalties per game over that span.

The Cajuns went 6-5 (.546) in 2005 to mark UL's first winning record since 1995. Bustle's squad went 4-7 (.364) in 2004, 4-8 (.333) in 2003 and 3-9 (.250) in 2002.

Along with a winning season in 2005 came a share of the Sun Belt Conference championship. After starting 1-5 (0-2), Louisiana roared back into the SBC race with a come-from-behind road win at Middle Tennessee. From there came a homecoming win over Troy in overtime and a second comeback road win, this time at North Texas. A Senior Day victory over Florida International then set-up the season finale at Louisiana-Monroe. The Cajuns rocked the Indians 54-21, claiming the first school title since the 1994 Big West crown.

Bustle was rewarded with a two-year contract extension following the 2005 campaign, which lengthens his contract through 2010.

Attendance has also been on the rise, as the Cajuns began 2003 with an attendance of 24,211 vs. Louisiana Tech, one of the twenty best in the history of Cajun Field, and largest crowd in seven seasons. Then, in 2004, UL saw a crowd of 25,083 for the Sun Belt opener vs. Middle Tennessee and a five-game total of 107,006, the most since 1996 and the eighth best average (21,401) in Cajun Field history. In 2005, UL played before a homecoming crowd of 21,204 en route to a solid two-season average of 19,496 – the best two year average at Cajun Field since 1992-93. Last season, the Cajuns homecoming crowd increased to 22,093, marking the third straight season with 20,000+ fans for homecoming.

During his tenure at UL, nine of Bustle's players have either been drafted or signed NFL contracts, including Charles Tillman and Ike Taylor. Both were selected in the 2003 NFL Draft and both have played in the Super Bowl. Taylor signed a five-year, \$22.5 million contract extension in Sept. 2006 that included a \$6.4 million signing bonus.

The Summerville, S.C., native, became the 24th head coach in Louisiana's Ragin' Cajuns football history on December 13, 2001.

Bustle earned his first collegiate victory as a head coach on Sept. 21, 2002 with a 34-0 victory over UAB. Louisiana-Lafayette held the Blazers to just eight first downs and only 94 yards passing.

In 2002, Bustle helped the Cajuns to their first winning record at Cajun Field in six seasons with impressive back-to-back victories over Sun Belt foes Idaho and Arkansas State.

In 2003, the Cajuns won four of their last five games en route to a second place finish in the Sun Belt Conference.

More importantly, Bustle's popularity across Acadiana had a significant impact in the stands. As a result, the Cajuns' season ticket base rose by substantial amounts.

Bustle has also been instrumental in developing his women's clinic held annually in the spring, attracting hundreds of enthusiastic females eager for knowledge of the game of football.

For seven seasons prior to his appointment as head coach of the Cajuns, Bustle served as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Va. Tech.

With the Hokies, Bustle developed some of the finest quarterbacks the college football world has seen in recent years. The list includes former 49ers quarterback Jim Druckenmiller and current Atlanta Falcons quarterback Michael Vick. Vick was the first overall selection in the 2001 NFL Draft.

In fact, Bustle coached the top three quarterbacks on Tech's career list for touchdown passes and guided players who have accounted for eight of the Hokies' Top 10 all-time single-season offensive totals and seven of Tech's Top 10 all-time single season passing totals.

The 1999 Hokies averaged a national-best 41.4 points per game, as Tech played in the national championship game. In Bustle's first seven seasons as offensive coordinator, the Hokies fielded seven of the eight highest-scoring teams in school history.

The team posted a 67-17 record and won three Big East Conference championships. VT went to a bowl game every year he served as offensive coordinator, winning the 1993 Independence Bowl, 1995 Sugar Bowl, 1998 Music City Bowl and 2001 Gator Bowl.

Bustle spent all but one season at Va. Tech from 1987-2001, leaving the Hokies in 1994 for a one-year stint as the offensive coordinator and QB's coach at South Carolina. While at SC, Bustle helped the Gamecocks go from a 4-7 record in 1993 to a 7-5 record and a Carquest Bowl Championship.

From 1987-92, he was the quarterbacks and receivers coach at Tech before moving to offensive coordinator and QB's coach in '93.

His ties to Louisiana include a three-year stint at Louisiana-Monroe from 1984-86, where he started as the running backs coach for two seasons before becoming the offensive coordinator and QB's coach.

He has also had coaching stints with East Carolina as a wide receivers and secondary coach (1980-82) and the USFL's Arizona Wranglers as a running backs coach (1983). He broke into the full-time coaching ranks as the defensive coordinator at Gardner-Webb in 1979.

Bustle is a 1976 graduate of Clemson, where he received a bachelor's degree in parks and recreation administration. He was a four-year letterwinner as a wide receiver for the Tigers.

As a graduate assistant coach, Bustle earned 27 hours toward a master's degree in Special Education.

Bustle's wife, Lynn, of Charleston, South Carolina, received her PhD. in curriculum and instruction from Virginia Tech in December 1997. She currently is a tenured professor at UL Lafayette in the Visual Arts Department in the College of the Arts. They have a son, Brad, who is an offensive lineman at UL.

## The 2007 Schedule...

Louisiana's Ragin' Cajuns 2007 football schedule features six home games for the second straight season and for the third time in the last five seasons. The homecoming game will kick-off at 4pm, while the other five games are set for a 6pm kick-off. All game times are subject to change.

The Cajuns are 15-12 at home under head coach Rickey Bustle and will enjoy five of the first eight games at Cajun Field.

UL will start the season with a road game on Sept. 1 at South Carolina. The Cajuns and Gamecocks opened the 2003 season in Columbia with UL almost pulling the upset, as SC escaped with a 14-7 victory.

The seventh annual Herbert Heymann Football Classic follows with a Sept. 8 meeting vs. Ohio at Cajun Field. The Bobcats were originally scheduled to play at Cajun Field during the 2006 season, but decided to buyout a two-year home-and-home contract. UL will now return the Bobcats visit with a trip to Athens, Ohio in 2010.

The HHFC marks the first game of a three-game homestand that continues with games vs. McNeese State on Sept. 15 and the Cajuns Sun Belt opener vs. Troy on Sept. 22.

The Cajuns and Cowboys will meet for the first time since 1986, renewing a series that spanned 35 years beginning in 1951. The first two games of the series were held in Lake Charles, before the series moved to Lafayette in 1953. The rivalry then alternated between Lake Charles and Lafayette each season.

With the exception of two years (1951 & 1974), the teams met in late November, usually as one of the last games each season. Louisiana won the last meeting between the schools 33-13 on Nov. 15, 1986 in Lake Charles.

The Cajuns step out of conference for a Sept. 29 meeting at Central Florida which caps the Golden Knights season-opening three-game homestand at the new \$47 million, 45,000-seat Bright House Networks Stadium. The trip to the UCF campus marks a return from the 2005 season.

Louisiana then returns home to face Sun Belt foe North Texas on Oct. 6 before starting a stretch of three straight homecoming games.

The Cajuns visit Arkansas State on Oct. 13 for the Indians homecoming. UL then travels back home to host Florida Atlantic in the 62<sup>nd</sup> homecoming in school history. After an open week, UL goes to Knoxville, Tenn. to face the Tennessee Volunteers for homecoming on Nov. 3. The Cajuns and Vols have met only one other time, a 38-3 Vols win on Sept. 5, 1992.

The Cajuns stay on the road to face Middle Tennessee in Murfreesboro on Nov. 10 and Florida International in Miami on Nov. 17.

The 2007 regular season comes to an end at Cajun Field versus Louisiana-Monroe on Nov. 24.

UL holds a 72-88-3 all-time record against their 2007 opponents.

## Who to watch...

### **#43 LB Brent Burkhalter, 6-0, 221, Jr.-2L, Baton Rouge, LA**

- Started 11 games as a sophomore in 2006
- Led the team with 61 total tackles, despite missing game vs. North Carolina A&T
- Was fourth on squad, and tops among LB's, with 4.5 tackles-for-loss
- Has made at least three tackles in 20 of 22 career games

### **#6 RG Michael Desormeaux, 6-1, 195, Jr.-2L, New Iberia, LA**

- Earned second team All-Sun Belt honors as an all-purpose specialist
- He was one of only 10 players in the country to play offense, defense and special teams – and was just one of two quarterbacks on that list
- He was a true all-purpose player, taking snaps at quarterback, lining up at wide receiver, playing defensive back in nickel and dime packages, serving as the personal protector on punts, playing on the punt block team and he recovered an onside kick on the hands team.

### **#32 RB Tyrell Fenroy, 5-10, 190, Jr.-2L, LaPlace, LA**

- A first team All-Sun Belt selection, he led all players in rushing yards and all-purpose yards by a wide margin in Sun Belt only games
- He averaged 5.5 yards per carry on the season and posted six 100-yard games, upping his career total to 11- the most in school history by a running back
  - His 1,197 rushing yards were the most in school history by a running back and made the sophomore the only player in school history with two 1,000-yard rushing seasons.

### **#79 C Chris Fisher, 6-3, 275, So.-1L, Lafayette, LA**

- Started 10 games as a redshirt freshman
- Named a Freshman All-American by *The Sporting News*
- Given the Cajuns Champion Award at the end of the season for most productive offensive newcomer

### **#90 DE Rodney Hardeway, 6-3, 235, Sr.-3L, Tyler, TX**

- Named honorable mention All-Sun Belt
- Led all Cajuns defensive linemen in tackles, tackles-for-loss and sacks
- He led the team with three forced fumbles and was among the SBC leaders in sacks and forced fumbles
- Each of his forced fumbles came at a crucial time in Sun Belt games
- Had 24 tackles in seven SBC games, including seven tackles vs. ASU.

### **#8 S Lamar Morgan, 6-2, 210, Sr.-3L, Copperas Cove, TX**

- One of three defense players to start all 12 games in 2006
- A fifth year senior in 2007, he boasts four career interceptions as a free safety
- His 53 tackles last season more than doubled his career total and ranked fourth on the team
- Top tackling performance came at Texas A&M as he recorded 14 total stops.

### **#67 LT Jesse Newman, 6-4, 301, Sr.-3L, Powell River, B.C.**

- Has started 34 career games
- Senior member of the Cajuns offensive line that has produced back-to-back 1,000-yard rushers
- Named 2005 Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference

### **#41 LB Antwyne Zanders, 6-0, 208, Jr.-1L, Kentwood, LA**

- Ranked fifth on the team in tackles and tackles-for-loss in first season
- Played in all 12 games during first season, earning first career start vs. North Carolina A&T
- Had a season best nine tackles at Texas A&M

University of Louisiana at Lafayette head football coach Rickey Bustle signed 18 players to National Letters of Intent. The signing class, which features four (4) Louisiana natives, marks the sixth for the University under Bustle.

Bustle and his assistants inked 16 high school student-athletes and two (2) junior college transfers. In addition to the four Louisiana commitments, the Cajuns coaching staff ventured outside the state to gain six (6) commitments from Florida, six (6) from Texas and two (2) from Alabama.

Louisiana-Lafayette signed eight (8) players on offense, nine (9) on defense and added one athlete.

"This class has a chance to be an exceptional class," Bustle said. "We were very fortunate to keep our local athletes at home and to get the numbers that we needed at each position.

"We were able to stay at the top of our list at each position," Bustle added. "We turned down some good football players and there were some hard decisions. I feel like this could be our most exciting class."

Bustle and his staff received two commitments from players who completed their prep careers in Lafayette. Both **Grant Fleming** and **Lance Kelley**, who prepped at Lafayette's own St. Thomas More High School, will be future Ragin' Cajuns.

Fleming signed with the Cajuns as a defensive back. He ended his high school career with 263 tackles (95 solo), 16 pass breakups and 14 interceptions.

Kelley committed to the Cajuns as a wide receiver. He was an all-around threat for STM putting up numbers as a quarterback, a rusher, a receiver and a kick returner while also stepping into the STM secondary in key situations.

The Ragin' Cajuns' 2007 signing class saw the program pick up two prospects at quarterback. Bustle and staff signed **Chris Masson** from Christopher Columbus High School in Miami and **Brad McGuire** from Gulf Breeze High School.

Masson completed 150-of-293 passes for 1,805 yards and 19 scores in his senior season at Columbus High School. He earned Third Team All-Dade County honors by the Miami Herald which ranked him as one of the two best quarterbacks in the Miami-Dade County area.

McGuire completed 67 percent of his passes as a senior at Gulf Breeze. He's an athletic quarterback with great pocket presence and a solid arm for the short to intermediate routes.

Joining Kelley as a commitment at wide receiver was **Jawanza Mitchell** from West Mesquite (Texas) High School. In his only season of football at West Mesquite, Mitchell caught 34 passes for 598 yards and nine touchdowns.

Louisiana-Lafayette's two junior college commitments will bring help at the cornerback position. The Cajuns inked **Justin Branden** from Pearl River Community College who had nine interceptions last season. **Scotter Rogers** from Fort Scott Community College was a member of the First Team All-Jayhawk Conference and a Second Team All-American in 2006.

The offensive line received a boost with the addition of Jaron Odom of Boyd Anderson in Fort Lauderdale and Kyle Plouhar of Fontainebleau High School in Mandeville. Odom checks in at 340 pounds and Plouhar at 295. Odom was a Second Team All-Broward County selection in 2006 and was a member of the Broward County All-Stars. Plouhar was listed among the Top 20 offensive linemen in the state of Louisiana.

One member of the signing class is already enrolled in school for the Spring 2007 semester. Defensive lineman **Jermaine Rogers** of Davidson High School in Mobile, Ala., will enjoy the benefits of the Cajuns' off-season program and spring practices.
